#### No 1

Bishop Norton

## Village Centre Circular Walk (1 mile)

#### Route

Turn left out of the Crown Inn car park, then turn left again onto Bishop Norton Rd. Continue onto the junction with Washdyke Lane and turn right.

Follow the road to the junction with

Middlefield Lane and

turn left. At the end of Middlefield Lane turn

left, back onto Bishop

Norton Rd. Continue on back

to the Crown Inn.

#### Alternative Route

Turn right off Bishop Norton Rd
at St Peter's Church and take
Little Hill down to the wooden
bridge over Seggimoor Beck, joining the
main walk on Washdyke Lane.

### Points of Interest

Take a few moments to visit the church and look at the mediaeval stone carving over the porch.

Opposite the junction with Washdyke Lane is the grade 2 listed Seggimoor Farm House. 'Seggimoor' is thought to be a corruption of the word 'sycamore'.

From the brow of the rise on Washdyke Lane there is a view to the right of the distant Wolds.
