

Glentham Walks

No 2

Village Centre Circular Walk (1.5 miles)

Route

Turn left out of the Crown Inn car park, then turn left again onto Bishop Norton Rd. Continue on to the junction with Washdyke Lane and turn right.

Follow the road to the junction with Middlefield Lane and turn right. At the junction with Barff Lane, turn left and continue on to the junction with Bishop Norton Rd. Turn left and return to the Crown Inn.

Alternative Route

At the junction of Washdyke Lane and Middlefield Lane go straight ahead along a public footpath between the houses (look for the telegraph pole).

Points of Interest

Take a few moments to visit the church and look at the mediaeval stone carving over the porch. Inside see the statue of Molly Grimes under the organ loft which was washed annually by seven maids. The Crown Inn is around 400 years old and was the meeting place of the Ancient Order of Foresters between 1838 and 1897.
